The Subordinate Judge, Palani, is hereby directed to issue fresh summon to the respondent after the case is transferred and renumbered.

5.With the above the directions, this Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition is allowed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
