PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.10 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent police

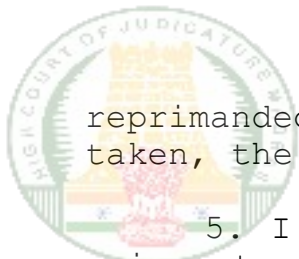
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under section 174 of Cr.P.C. @ into Section 306 of I.P.C., in Crime No.10 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The case was initially registered under Section 174 of Cr.P.C. The petitioner is the school principal. The deceased was her student.

4. The petitioner's counsel would point that the deceased was having love affair with a fellow student and since he was



reprimanded by the petitioner herein and consequential action was taken, the occurrence in question had taken place.

5. I am of the view that the arrest of the petitioner is not going to serve any purpose. Hence, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on her appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Musiri, and on her executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
