PRAYER :-

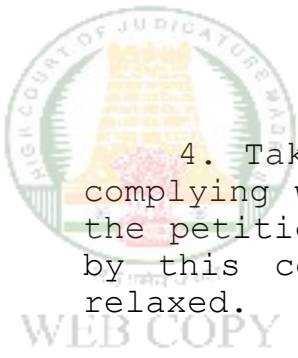
To relax the conditions imposed on the petitioners in Crl.O.P.
