PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.23 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent
Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and
the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the
respondent.

2. The petitioners are in custody since 22.01.2020 for the
offences punishable under sections 379 of IPC read with Section 21
(4) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulations) Act, 1957,
in Crime No. 23 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police. They
seek bail.

3. Taking note of the facts and circumstances of this case, I
am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail with certain
conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released
on bail, subject to the following conditions;

Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate No.3, Thanjavur.

(ii) the petitioners are directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for the interrogation.

(iii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
