PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

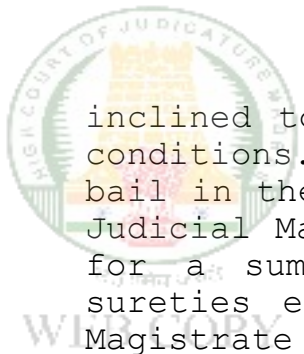
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 12 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under section 379 of I.P.C., in Crime No.12 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The defacto complainant has alleged that his two wheeler got stolen. It is seen that the petitioner's wife is the original owner of the vehicle in question. The petitioner would allege that her signatures were forged and the name was changed in the R.C. book. Based on the name change, this complaint has been lodged. The vehicle is very much in the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner was the original owner of the vehicle and it is also in his possession then it is not a case for arrest. Hence, I am



inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Kuzhithurai, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

4. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
