for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.39 of 2020 on the file of the
respondent police.

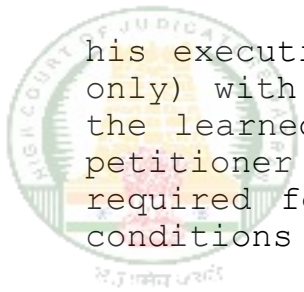
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 143,
153A, 188, 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.39 of 2020 on the file of
the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3.Thiru.M.Anwar Hussain, is present in person before this
Court. He informs the Court that his daughter's wedding is fixed on
09.02.2020. He states that as a result of his implication in the
case on hand, he was not able to make arrangements for his
daughter's marriage. The petitioner states that he genuinely
regrets having uttered the offending words. He also gives an
undertaking that he will not speak in a similar fashion hereafter.

4. Recording the petitioner's undertaking, I am inclined to
grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.
Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the
event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial
Magistrate Court No.1, Padmanabapuram, Kanyakumari District, and on



his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
