PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

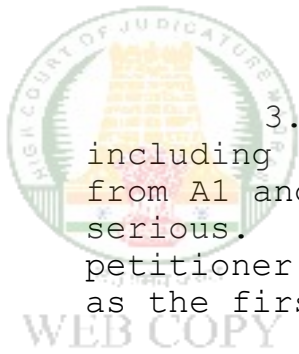
PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 3/2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 9, 39 (3), 51 read with 51 of Wild Life Protection Act, 2002, in Crime No. 3 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.



3. The first petitioner is having three previous cases including the case on hand. 800 Kgs of sea-cucumber was recovered from A1 and A2. The allegation against the second petitioner is not serious. Therefore, I am inclined to grant relief to the second petitioner and this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as far as the first petitioner herein.

4. Accordingly, second petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court NO.II, Thoothukudi, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the second petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The second petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The second petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
