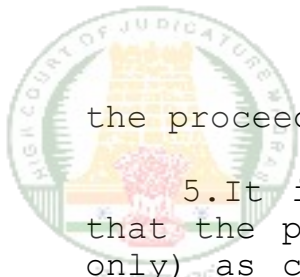
ORDER

The Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in D.V.C.No.1 of 2019, on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Keeranur, Pudukottai District.

2.The case is under trial. By passage of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3.A Joint Memo of Compromise has been filed before this Court, which have been signed by the petitioner and the second respondent and also by their respective counsel. In order to identify the respective parties they have also produced the copy of the Aadhaar Card which is made part of the record. This Court also enquired both the parties and was satisfied that the parties have come to an amicable settlement between themselves.

4.Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the proceedings pending, even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in **2017 9 SCC 641- (Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Guj Rath)**, this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. quashes



the proceedings in D.V.C.No.1 of 2019.

5.It is represented by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner paid a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) as costs to the Credit of M.S.Chellamuthu Trust and Research Foundation, 643, K.K.Nagar, Madurai and filed the original cash receipt along with this memo on 10.02.2020. The said submission is placed on record.

6.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in D.V.C.No.1 of 2019, on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Keeranur, Pudukottai District, is quashed and the terms of joint compromise memo shall form part and parcel of this order. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
