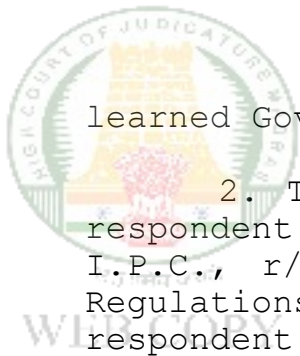
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under section 379 of I.P.C., r/w Section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulations) Act, 1957, in Crime No.64 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners undertakes to deposit a sum of Rs.5,500/-each to the bank account of the Superintendent, Government Observation Home, Kamarajar Salai, Madurai, bearing Ac.No.161401000024282, MICR Code: 625020012, IFSC Code:IOBA0001614, Indian Overseas Bank, Teppakulam Branch, Madurai.

4. Recording the petitioner's undertaking, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Srivilliputhur, Virudhunagar District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only)each with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
