PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C
PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.9 of 2020 on the file of the
Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under section 379 of
I.P.C., r/w Section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and
Regulation) Act, 1957, in Crime No.9 of 2020 on the file of the
respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The petitioner's counsel states that the petitioner is not the
owner of the vehicle in question. The vehicle has been recovered.

4.It is not known as to why the owner of the vehicle has not
been implicated as an accused in this case. Three units of sand is
involved. The petitioner is not having any previous case.
Therefore, anticipatory bail is granted on condition that the
petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.22,500/- to the bank account of
the Superintendent, Government Observation Home, Kamarajar Salai,



Madurai, bearing Ac.No.161401000024282, MICR Code: 625020012, IFSC Code:IOBA0001614, Indian Overseas Bank, Teppakulam Branch, Madurai.

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Thanjavur, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
