PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

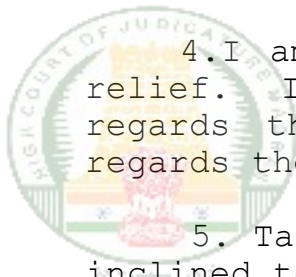
PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.61 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 336 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., and Section 4 of TNWH Act, in Crime No.61 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. Though overt acts are attributed against the petitioners herein, it is seen that the third Petitioner Chellapandi, had hit one Suresh Kannan leading to loss of a teeth. Therefore, he has to undergo surgery.



4. I am of the view that the other petitioners can be granted relief. In this view of the matter, this petition is dismissed as regards the third petitioner. Anticipatory bail is granted as regards the other petitioners.

5. Taking note of the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners 1, 2 and 4 to 7 with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners 1, 2 and 4 to 7 are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Additional Mahila Court (Magistrate Level), Madurai, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners 1, 2 and 4 to 7 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners 1, 2 and 4 to 7 shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners 1, 2 and 4 to 7 shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
