PRAYER :-

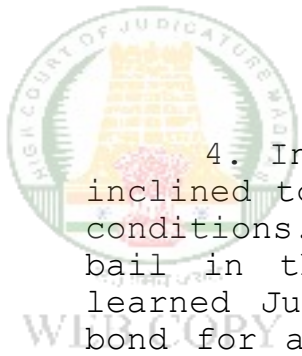
for Anticipatory bail in Crime No.10 of 2020 on the file of the

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 147,
148, 294(b), 353, 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.10 of 2020 on the
file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3.The petitioners had misbehaved with the police. Therefore
this Court directed the petitioners to go to the respondent police
station and convey their apologies in person. The petitioners went
to the police station and conveyed their apology in person and
photograph of the same has also been furnished by the learned
counsel for the petitioners.



4. In view of the subsequent conduct of the petitioners, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Devakottai, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
