PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 74/2020 on the file of the
Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and
the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the
respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences under sections 294(b), 341, 342,
307 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.74 of 2020 on the file of the
respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The defacto complainant is said to be engaged in some minor
manufacturing activity. The same is considered as nuisance by the
petitioner herein. This is the cause for the occurrence. The first
petitioner is said to have hit the victim with iron rod on his head.
The second petitioner had also assaulted him. The victim is said to
have been in hospital for about five days.

4. The petitioners' counsel on instructions states that the
<https://hcservices.courts.gov.in/hcservices/> take a demand draft for a sum of Rs.5,000/-



favouring the victim and enclose the same along with the surrender petition. The Court below shall take steps to hand over the same to the victim. Of course, this will be without prejudice to the petitioners' defence in the trial.

5. Recording the said undertaking, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Dindigul, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
