on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

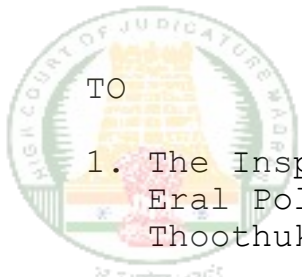
3. The petitioner's earlier petition for anticipatory bail was
