for Bail in Crime No.182 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police

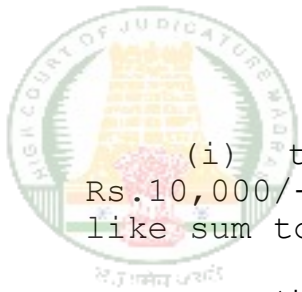
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner is in custody since 10.10.2019 for the offences under Section Girl Missing @ 363 IPC @ 366 of I.P.C and 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 in Crime No.182 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police. Hence, he seeks bail.

3. Investigation has been completed and final reported had already been filed. The case was taken on file in S.C.No.86 of 2019 on the file of the learned Mahila Court, Theni.

4. Since investigation is fully completed, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions;



(i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Mahila Court, Theni District.

(ii) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for the interrogation.

(iii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
