3.The Contempt Petition stands closed.

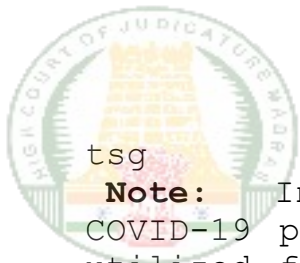
