Situate in Karaikudi-Ramanathapuram National Highway-Thennevayal Village-27/4B, 21/8B, 35/2 of Thennevayal Village of Devakkottai Taluka of Sivagangai District, to the petitioner by considering petitioner's representation dated 19.02.2019

The learned Additional Government Pleader, on instructions, submitted that the petitioner has not appeared for the enquiry, though notice was issued to him on 31.12.2019. 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the contempt petition is closed. It is open to the petitioner to appear before the respondent and thereafter, the respondent may dispose of the appeal within a period of four weeks from the date of completing enquiry.
