4.Recording the same, the writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

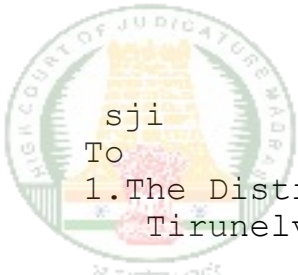
