PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 7/2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent and the learned counsel appearing for the intervenor.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 420, 465 and 468 of I.P.C., in Crime No.7 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The complainant is the mother-in-law of the first petitioner herein. The case of the mother-in-law is that fake LIC polices have been obtained in her name and that the wife of the



first petitioner is shown as nominee. The complainant apprehends that she will be done to death and that the policy amount will be appropriated by the first petitioner herein.

4. I am of the view that in a case of this nature, arrest of the petitioners is not necessary. Hence, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Muthugulathur, Ramnad District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
