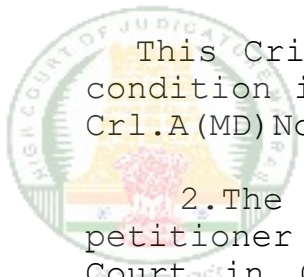
PRAYER IN Crl.MP(MD)No.1395 of 2020:
