PRAYER :-

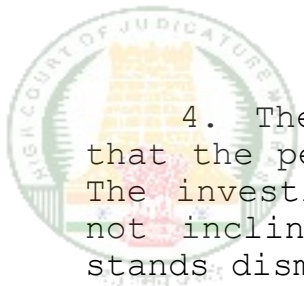
for Bail in Crime No.119 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner is in custody since 24.01.2020 for the offences under Section 489(B) of I.P.C. in Crime No.119 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police. Hence, he seeks bail.

3. A1 and A2 were got red-handed. Following their interrogation, the involvement of A3 came to light. Following the interrogation of A3, the involvement of petitioner herein came to light.
