PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

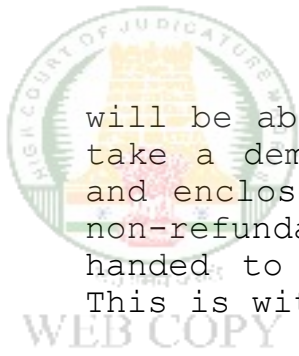
for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.4 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under sections 417, 376 and 506 (ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.4 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The defacto complainant and A1 had intimacy with each other and the victim is five months pregnant. It appears that the marriage between the victim and A1 was also conducted in a local temple. The petitioners are only in-laws. A1 is said to be absconding. Be that as it may, this Court suggested that the petitioner ought to pay certain amount to the victim so that she



will be able to deliver the child. The petitioner comes forward to take a demand draft for a sum of Rs.50,000/- favouring the victim and enclose the same along with their surrender petition. This is non-refundable deposit. The said original demand draft will be handed to the victim by the Court below through the respondent. This is without prejudice to the petitioners' defence in the trial.

5. Subject to these conditions, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Thoothukudi, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
