Prayer in CMP(MD)No.1912/2020 :-

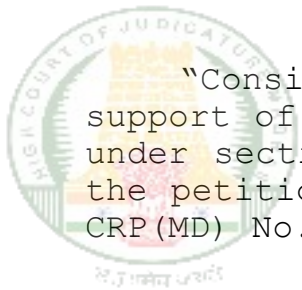
