PRAYER :-

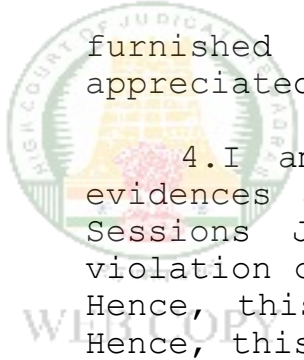
to cancel the bail granted to the 1st Respondent by the

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the
learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

2.This petition has been filed for cancellation of bail. The
learned Principal District Sessions Judge, after hearing
accused/petitioner as well as the defacto complainant, who
intervened in the bail petition, has gone through the material
available in the Case Diary file and being satisfied with the same,
came forward to release the accused/petitioner on bail on condition.

3.Now, the defacto complainant has filed a petition for
cancelling bail stating that the bail was obtained by the accused
person by suppressing the fact. The learned counsel appearing for
the defacto complainant would make attempt to convince this Court
that the materials collected by the Police and the materials



furnished by him in support of his complaint not properly appreciated.

4.I am afraid that it is not stage to appreciate all the evidences and interfere in a bail petition. Since the Principal Sessions Judge has applied her mind and granted bail and no violation of bail condition brought out to the notice of this Court. Hence, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the bail order. Hence, this criminal original petition is dismissed.
