PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.77 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

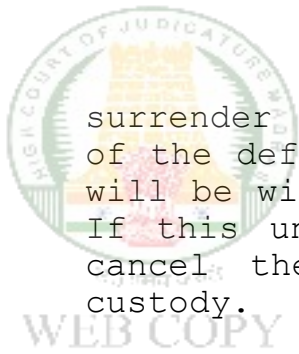
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under sections 353 and 506(i) of I.P.C., in Crime No.77 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The Executive Officer, Neikkarapatti Panchayat Union, Dindigul, is the defacto complainant. His specific allegation is that the petitioner is threatening him for doing his public duty.

4. The petitioner's counsel on instructions states that the petitioner will file an affidavit before the Court at the time of



surrender that he will desist from interfering with the activities of the defacto complainant. Of course, execution of such affidavit will be without prejudice to the petitioner's defence in the trial. If this undertaking is breached, this Court will not hesitate to cancel the relief now granted and commit the petitioner into custody.

5. Recording the said undertaking, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Palani, Dindigul District, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
