ORDER

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondents 1 and 2.

Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 would submit that there is a dispute between two parties in the village with regard to conducting the festival and thereby, on the request of the second respondent, the matter was referred to the first respondent for conducting a peace committee meeting. The first respondent had summoned persons belonging to both parties to conduct the meeting on 19.02.2020. During the meeting, no consensus was arrived between the parties and thereby, the permission cannot be given.

4. Recording the same, the writ petition stands closed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
