#### ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in Crime No.51 of 2017 dated 18.01.2017 on the file of the respondent police for the offences under Sections 143,341 and 188 of IPC.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the facts of the case are exactly similar to the case covered in the decision reported in **2018 2 LW (Crl) 606 [Jeevanandham and others vs. The Inspector of Police Velayuthampalayam Police Station, Karur District] dated 20.09.2018**



and in the case of **Sri Raja vs Inspector of Police, Sivakasi Town Police Station Virudhunagar District and other** in batch of cases in **Crl.O.P(MD) No.7922 of 2019 dated 30.08.2019**

3. The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the facts of the case are similar to the facts covered under the Judgment referred above.

4. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent.

The facts of this case is similar to the facts covered by the Judgment of this Court reported in **2018 2 LW (Crl) 606 [Jeevanandham and others vs. The Inspector of Police Velayuthampalayam Police Station, Karur District] dated 20.09.2018** and in case of **Sri Raja vs Inspector of Police, Sivakasi Town Police Station Virudhunagar District and other** in batch of cases in **Crl.O.P(MD) No.7922 of 2019 dated 30.08.2019**. Accordingly, the proceedings in Crime No.51 of 2017 dated 18.01.2017 on the file of the respondent police is hereby quashed insofar as the petitioner alone and the Criminal Original Petition is allowed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
