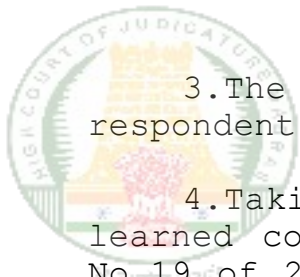
Prayer in CRL A(MD). 19/ 2020 :

ORDER:- This Petition coming on for orders on this day and upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.A.Haja Mohideen, Advocate for the Petitioner and of Mr.A.P.G.Ohm Chairma Prabhu, Government Advocate (Crl Side) for the respondent R1 and R2, this Court made the following order:
