PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.41 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent Police

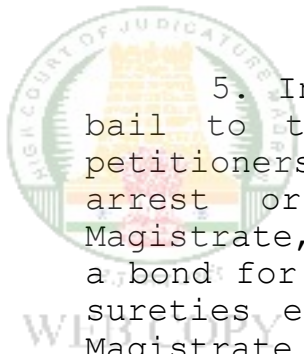
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 363, 323 and 506(i) of I.P.C., in Crime No. 41 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. There is a possibility of the respondent police filing an alteration report. The learned counsel for the petitioners clearly states that the so-called victim is very much in the hospital as of now. He has got himself voluntarily admitted.

4. According to the learned counsel for the petitioners, the first petitioner's wife Revathi is being blackmailed by Bharathi, the defacto complainant's son. Since the petitioner is likely to be implicated in a case of non-bailable nature, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.



5. In view of the above, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thirumayam, Pudukkottai District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
