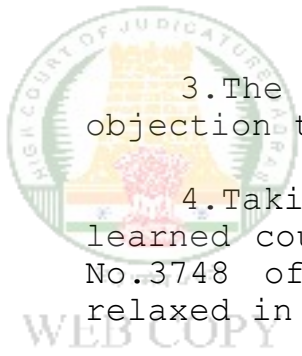
Prayer in CRL MP(MD). 3748/ 2019 :
