For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.44 of 2020 on the file of the
Respondent Police

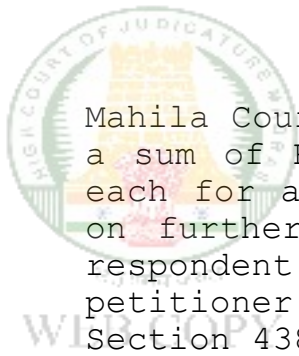
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the
learned counsel appearing for the intervener and the learned
Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences under sections 494, 294(b), 420,
406 and 506(i) of I.P.C., in Crime No.44 of 2020 on the file of the
respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. It is seen that the defacto complainant is the wife of A1
and several proceedings are pending between them. The defacto
complainant alleges that there is intimacy between this petitioner
and A1. In fact the complainant would allege that the petitioner
has married A1.

4. I am of the view that arrest or custodial interrogation of
the petitioner is not at all warranted. Hence, I am inclined to
grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.
Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the
sum of Rs. 10,000/- or on her appearance before the learned Additional



Mahila Court (Magistrate), Dindigul, and on her executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Court concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Court within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
