Respondent police

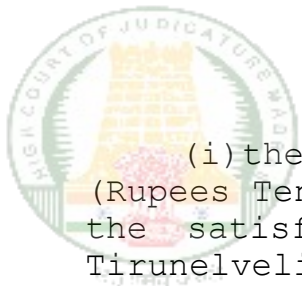
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2.The petitioner is in custody since 14.02.2020 for the
offences under Sections 294(b, 353, 307, 506(2) and 379 of IPC in
Crime No.375 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police. He seeks
bail.

3.The learned Government Adovcate (crl.side) opposes the grant
of bail by pointing out the bad antecedents of the petitioner. I
went through the catalogue of the cases. It is seen that the
petitioner was involved in IPC offences.

4.Hence, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with
certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be
released on bail, subject to the following conditions;



(i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate No.5, Tirunelveli, Tirunelveli District.

(ii) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for the interrogation.

(iii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
