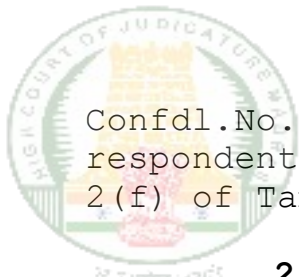

This habeas corpus petition has been filed by the mother of the detenu, namely, P.Jeyamurugan, son of Patchaiparumal, aged about 23 years, challenging the detention order in H.S.(M)



Confdl.No.09/2020, dated 28.01.2020, passed by the first respondent, branding him as "Goonda" as contemplated under Section 2(f) of Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondents, by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.1391, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XII) Department, dated 16.03.2020, would state that the impugned detention order has been revoked.

3. Recording the above submissions, the habeas corpus petition is closed.
