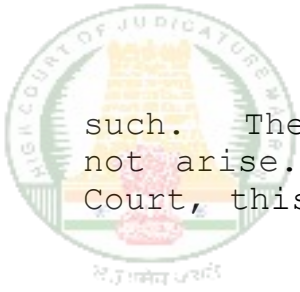

such. Therefore, the question of granting police protection does not arise. Leaving open the petitioner's right to move the Civil Court, this criminal original petition stands dismissed.
