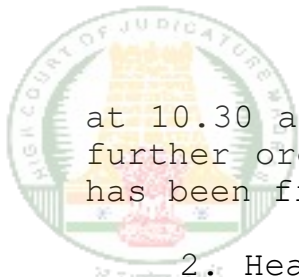
Prayer in CRL A(MD). 496/ 2019 :

Accused No.1 - U/s.302 of IPC - Life imprisonment and Fine amount Rs.5000 i/d. 1 year R.I and U/s.201 of IPC - 7 years R.I and fine amount Rs.5000 i/d. 6 months R.I.

Order: This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.R.ALAGUMANI, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.R.ANANDHARAJ, Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondents the court made the following order:-

[Order of the Court was made by **P.N.PRAKASH, J**]

This Court, by order dated 26.11.2019 in Crl.M.P.(MD)No.9835 of 2019 in Crl.A.(MD)No.496 of 2019, suspended the sentence and released the petitioner on bail on certain conditions, one of which is that the petitioner shall report before the trial Court everyday



at 10.30 a.m. and before the respondent Police at 05.30 p.m., until further orders. For relaxing the aforesaid condition, this petition has been filed.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent.

3. On instructions, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner has been complying with the above condition since he was released from custody.

4. In view of the above, the aforesaid condition stands relaxed. However, the petitioner shall report before the Trial Court on the first working day of every English Calendar month at 10.30 a.m., pending disposal of the Criminal Appeal and if he is not able to appear before the Trial Court on any day, he shall make arrangements to file an application under Section 317 Cr.P.C. and shall appear before the Trial Court on any other day in lieu of the date of his absence, as directed by the trial Court.

Accordingly, this Miscellaneous Petition stands ordered.
