PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

to cancel the bail granted to the 2nd respondent/accused No.2 by the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Madurai, in Cr.M.P.No.1020 of 2020, dated 02.03.2020, in Crime No.2165 of 2019, on the file of 1st respondent

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The bail was granted to the accused by invoking Section 167 (2) of Cr.P.C., since the accused was in jail for more than 65 days for the alleged offences under Sections 406 and 420 I.P.C.

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State submitted that the second respondent is still in jail, since he has not complied with the bail conditions.



3. Under such circumstances, the petition for cancellation of bail does not arise. Hence, the Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
