ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent police.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the respondent police while patrol duty, they intercepted a lorry bearing registration No.TN 69 AX 9029 and checked the vehicle, which was carrying three units of river sand without any valid permit.

3.According to the investigation, the petitioner herein is the main person, who has organized illicit mining of the river sand.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the state would submit that the petitioner is having five previous cases. It is the sixth case similar in nature.



5.Considering the bad antecedent of the petitioner and the illegal act of mining river sand, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed.
