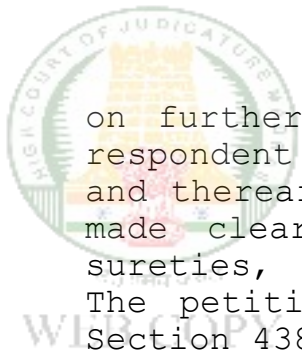




on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent Police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of three weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. It is also made clear in the event of any further delay to furnish the sureties, the respondent police shall act in accordance with law. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C., scrupulously.

4. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate on or before 31.03.2020, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
