Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.S.PALANI VELAYUTHAM, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.A.ANANDHARAJ, Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

This Court, by order dated 07.11.2019 in Crl.M.P.(MD)No.7603 of 2019 in Crl.A(MD)No.382 of 2019, suspended the sentence and released the petitioner on bail on certain conditions, one of which is that the petitioner shall report before the trial Court on all working days at 10.30 a.m. and before the respondent Police on holidays at 05.30 p.m., until further orders. For relaxing the aforesaid condition, this petition has been filed.



2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent.

3. On instructions, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner has been complying with the above condition since he was released from custody.

4. In view of the above, the aforesaid condition stands relaxed. However, the petitioner shall report before the Trial Court on the first working day of every English Calendar month at 10.30 a.m., pending disposal of the Criminal Appeal and if he is not able to appear before the Trial Court on any day, he shall make arrangements to file an application under Section 317 Cr.P.C. and shall appear before the Trial Court on any other day in lieu of the date of his absence, as directed by the trial Court.

Accordingly, this Miscellaneous Petition stands ordered.
