ORDER

Considering the facts and circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, a direction is given to the learned District Munsif Judge, Thiruvadanai, to dispose of the Suit in O.S.No.23 of 2016, pending on his file, as expeditiously as possible, in any event, not later than six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
