3. As per the order of this Court one of the condition imposed by this Court was to deposit maintenance amount of



Rs.5000/- on or before 10th of every month. Instead of depositing the amount on 10.03.2020, the first petitioner has deposited the amount on 13.03.2020, i.e., with the delay of three days. Hence the petitioners are before this Court seeking condonation of delay by extending the time for deposit.

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4. Since the petitioners have complied with the condition substantially though with delay, the said delay of three days is condoned and the petition is ordered accordingly.
