PRAYER :-

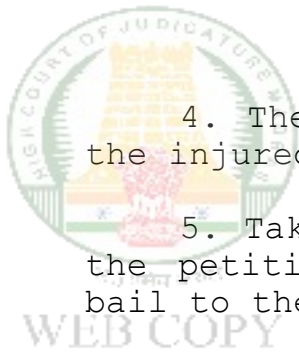
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.67 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323,324 and 506(ii) of IPC seek anticipatory bail.

3.It is a case and counter case. According to the First Information Report, the petitioners have assaulted the defacto complainant with wooden log and chappal.
