PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.354 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 4(1) (aa), 4(1)(g), 4(1-A), Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act r/w Section 269 IPC in Crime No.354 of 2020, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. Heard both sides.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State would submit that on information, they conducted ride and found fermented liquor in the coconut farm owned by the second accused. During the lock down period, the petitioner along with other accused have indulged in brewing illicit liquor. Hence, he opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



4.Considering the above submission, since the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is essential to find out the source and intention, this petition seeking anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
