It is seen that the Government of India has put in place a robust mechanism under 'VANDE BHARAT' Mission for evacuation of Indians stranded abroad and while bringing them into the Country, they are medically examined and are kept in compulsory quarantine.



2. Mr.K.K.Ramesh, petitioner / party-in-person, contended that even in the future, such a scheme must be made permanent.

3. In the opinion of this Court, a direction, as prayed for, cannot be granted, as the prayer, indeed, is an omnibus one and there are several stakeholders, whose views should have to be elicited before the Government puts in place a protocol to deal with international passengers.

Hence, this Writ Petition stands closed. No costs.
