PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a writ of habeas corpus calling for the records pertaining to the impugned detention order passed by the second respondent made in his proceedings in Cr.M.P.No.47/2020, dated 26.05.2020 in detaining the detenu under Section 2(b) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 as a Bootlegger and quash the same and direct the respondents to produce the detenu viz., Balasubramaniam, S/o. Natarajan, Male, aged about 30 years, who is detained in Central Prison, Trichy, before this Court and set him at liberty.
