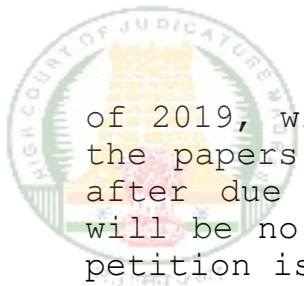

2.
