PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

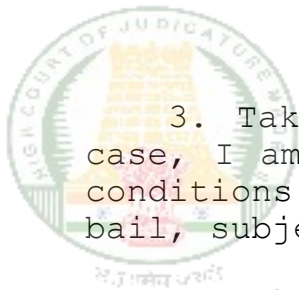
PRAYER :-

To enlarge the Petitioner/Accused No.1 on Bail in Cr.No.259 of 2020 dated 12.05.2020 on the file of the Respondent Police and pass such further or other orders as this Court.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner is arrayed as accused No.1. He was arrested and remanded to Judicial Custody on 13.05.2020 for the offences punishable under sections 294(b), 353, 379, 506(ii) of I.P.C., and Section 21(4) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act 1957 and Sections 25(1)(b) and 25(1-B)(a) of Arms Act 1959 in Crime No.259 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police. He seeks bail.



3. Taking note of the overall facts and circumstances of this case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions;

(i) the petitioner shall be released on own bond by the Magistrate without insisting on sureties. However, the petitioner is directed to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Ramanathapuram District, after the concerned Court is reopened.

(ii) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

(iii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560].
