PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime no.67 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2.The petitioner is in custody since 20.05.2020 for the offences punishable under Sections 6(4) of Tamil Nadu Scheduled Commodities (RDSCS) Order, 1982 r/w 7(1)(a)(ii) of Essential Commodities Act, 1955 in Crime No.67 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police and seeks bail.

3.Considering the overall facts and circumstances, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions;

(i) the petitioner shall be released on own bond by the Magistrate without insisting on sureties. However, the petitioner is directed to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties,

Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Thiruchirapalli, after the concerned Court is reopened.

(ii) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

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(iii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560].
