PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Cr.no.51 of 2020 in the file of the
Respondent Police

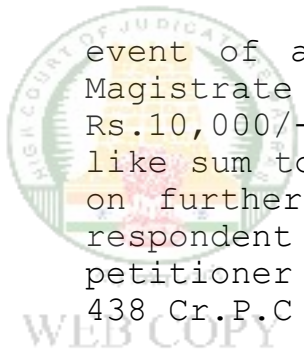
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences under section 379 of I.P.C. r/w.
Section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation)
Act,1957. in Crime No.51 of 2020, on the file of the respondent
police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) states that the
petitioner illegally transported 1/4 unit of sand.

4.Taking note of the facts and circumstances of the case,
anticipatory bail is granted with certain conditions. The petitioner
undertakes to deposit a sum of Rs.3,500/- (Rupees Three Thousand
Five Hundred Only) as non refundable deposit to the credit of Crime
No.51 of 2020, before the jurisdictional Court. It will be without
prejudice to the petitioner's defence in the trial. The said amount
will be transferred by the Court to the account of any relief fund
that may be maintained by the district administration. The district
administration shall spend the amount for any welfare activity and
also submit user certificate to the Registry of this Court. On such
deposit, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the



event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.2, Thanjavur and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of eight weeks from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
