PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.55 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 294(b), 307 of I.P.C., @ 294(b), 307, 114 of I.P.C., r/w 120(b) IPC, in Crime No. 55 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. In this case the victim was stabbed by the second accused viz., Krishna Moorthy. The petitioner's name is not figuring in the F.I.R.



4. According to the confession made by the co-accused, the petitioner is said to have ridden the vehicle. The person, who inflicted the injury, has already been arrested. The petitioner is not having any previous case.

5. Taking note of the facts and circumstances, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Tiruchendur, Tuticorin District, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 8 weeks from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
